

JUNE 1, 2016

A regular meeting of the City Council was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by the President of the Council, Dan Hammond.

PRESENT Council members Sorensen, Pankratz, Workman, Hammond, Hofmeister, and Jensen. Also present were Terri Miller, Jeremy Peirsol, Chief Wilkinson, and Nolan Wittrock.

EXCUSED: Mayor Beitia.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

ADD EMERGENCY ITEM: **Motion** made by Sorensen, seconded by Jensen, to add emergency item to the agenda regarding declaration of unsafe sidewalks. Motion carried by unanimous vote of those members present.

CONSENT AGENDA: **Motion** made by Hofmeister, Seconded by Workman, to approve the Consent agenda as printed and distributed. Motion carried by unanimous vote of those members present.

DECLARATION OF UNSAFE SIDEWALKS: **Motion** made by Workman, seconded by Pankratz, to serve written notice on 141, 161, and 169 Polk St. for declaration of unsafe Sidewalks according to city ordinances 913 and 914. Motion carried by unanimous vote of those members present.

DISCUSSION ON SPRAYER AND TRACTOR EXCHANGE: The exchange would be for Cody to use the city's sprayer to spray weeds for Lance Funk in exchange for the city to use Lance Funk's tractor for aerating the course. Cody would provide the sprayer and operator. Lance would provide the chemicals. Nolan said a MOU would be needed. **Motion** made by Pankratz, seconded by Workman, to approve the attorney to do a MOU between The City and Lance Funk to trade for Cody to use the sprayer and providing an operator to spray weeds for Funk in exchange for the use of Funk's tractor for aerating the golf course for a two week period. Motion carried by unanimous vote of those members present.

PIGGY BACK OFF HIGHWAY DISTRICT CONTRACT: **Motion** made by Hofmeister, seconded by Workman, to approve the street department to piggy back off of the Power County Highway District gravel and oil bids. Motion carried by unanimous vote of those members present.

DISCUSSION ON FIBER OPTICS: Daniel Parrish, from Direct Communications, spoke about how slow American Falls internet is and the city needs a better solution. They would like to bring fiber optics to the city. Direct Communications is partnering with Fat Beam. They were requesting the use of a cabinet in the building for equipment and would need 24 hours access. Nolan, the city's attorney, will look into the legalities of an agreement.

MAY BILLS: Motion made by Workman, seconded by Jensen, to approve May bills as Printed and distributed. Motion carried by unanimous vote of those members present.

There being no further business to come before the council, the meeting was adjourned at 8:00 p.m. upon motion duly made and passed, to reconvene on June 15, 2016 for Regular Council.
